

Questions for reflection.

(not intended to be a sermon outline)

You are encouraged to use these as part of a study/devotional/reflection time through the coming week.

You are also encouraged to participate in the Explore Class after worship where we will use these as a discussion starter.

- 1. What questions does today's message raise for you?*
- 2. Have you had much teaching on the Holy Spirit? Do you feel you understand the workings and ways of the Holy Spirit? Are you interested in more teaching focus on the Trinity and Holy Spirit in particular?*
- 3. How would you describe the working of the Holy Spirit? What do you understand about His role in your life and in the world?*
- 4. Ephesians 2:8 states we are saved by grace through faith- and faith is a gift of God. Do you see faith as a gift? Or more as a realization you come to on your own?*
- 5. What was your path to faith? Does it seem like the Holy Spirit was guiding that path?*
- 6. How can our free will work with God's irresistible gift of grace to save us? Describe "irresistible grace."*

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7. Can we deny the gift of faith? How might God work to bring you to that point?

8. Do you feel God should not force faith onto anyone? Does He have the right to Transform you without your permission?

9. Explain the difference between an outward call to faith and an inward call to faith.
(A calling to all and a calling to you personally.)

10. Define "Common Grace" and "Saving Grace."

11. What is the difference between the Holy Spirit working for your salvation and working for your sanctification?

12. Has what we have been talking about in this Lenten series fitting together? What might be your resistance or struggle with it be?

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
