Questions for reflection. (not intended to be a sermon outline) You are encouraged to use these as part of a study/devotional/reflection time through the coming week. You are also encouraged to participate in the Explore Class after worship where we will use these as a discussion starter. Bring your questions as well for discussion.

- 1. What questions does today's message raise for you?
- 2. What do you think the listeners to Jesus at the Sermon on the Mount thought of his description of the Kingdom in the beatitudes? What might cause resistance?
- 3. Is it difficult to imagine being a new creation in Christ? How do you understand that? How do you describe being new? What is "new?"
- 4. Why does personal transformation precede corporate transformation?
- 5. Pastor talked about a "Triple Loop Transformation." 1. Doing the same things differently. 2. Doing different things. 3. Being different.
 - a. Give an example of each stage.

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- b. How does this connect with you personally in your spiritual growth? Share stories of how you may have worked through the loops.
- c. How does this connect with FRC in its ministry? How has FRC sought transformation? Give examples of the loops and desires to move forward. How does previous actions fit into the different loops?
- 6. What are the challenges of moving forward in the transformational loops?
 - a. Describe what it might look like for a person to go through the loop stages.
 - b. Describe what it might look like for a church to go through the transformational stages? What trial and error steps might be tried or taken?
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
