Women's Bible Study will meet Wednesday, August 21st at 6:30 p.m.

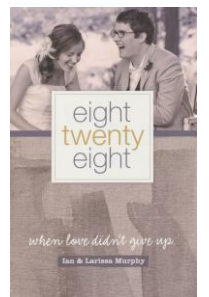
The Annville Trailer is coming the beginning of September.
